All Around Panthers All-Stars is a competitive cheerleading program that focuses on building strong people as well as strong athletes. Emphasis is placed on effort, teamwork, trust, and good sportsmanship, both on and off the competition and practice floors. Athletes are expected to be respectful of all coaches, teammates, parents, and competitors. We have terrific coaches who push every girl to reach her greatest potential. All athletes, coaches, and parents are expected to give their full commitment to the success of the program and all of its athletes.

Try-outs:

Try-outs will be held April 15th through the 24th, and are open to anyone age 5 to 18 as of May 31, 2008. Athletes will be evaluated on a number of skills including motions & dance, jumps, tumbling, and stunting, as well as flexibility and general physical conditioning. Girls should wear shorts and T-shirts or tank tops. No long sleeves or pants. Clothes should be fitted, but not overly tight or revealing. Athletic shoes are required. In addition to the physical skills, coaches will also be looking at attitude, how well the athletes work together, and their willingness to accept instruction. Teams will be assigned based on age, ability, and the number of athletes attending try-outs. Attending try-outs does not require you to be on a team, however if after attending try-outs you think you may not be ready for this kind of obligation, please let the coaches know so that teams can be formed accordingly. Bids to teams will be handed out on Monday April 28th. The decisions of the coaching staff are final. Anyone accepting their bid will be expected to pay the first month's tuition by the first practice. Practice will begin the week of May 5th. If you have any questions, please stop in before or after a clinic, or call the gym at (440) 358-0111 and ask to speak with Lisa.

Try-out Fee:

\$40 per girl - payable to AAGA

Flat Fee due at the time of registration - No refunds

A personal information form and liability waiver must be signed at the time of registration.

These must be turned in before the athlete can participate.

Monthly gym fees range from \$75 - \$120 and are due on the first of the month, payable to AAGA. All cheerleaders are also required to pay a once yearly registration/insurance fee, due in September. In addition to gym fees, cheerleaders are required to purchase their own uniform, including all accessories. The cost to purchase all items brand new is about \$550. However, used items are often available. There are also fees to attend competitions. These fees are usually around \$500 for the year and are paid to the All Around Cheer Boosters. A \$100 deposit for competition fees is due in May. This is a full year obligation, and should not be taken lightly. All practices and competitions are mandatory. Each individual on a team affects the success of the team as a whole. All cheerleaders and parents need to be fully committed to the team to make this program a success.
